THE PROBLEM

Major projects carry increasing Indigenous participation requirements, creating pressure across delivery, compliance, and reporting.

Most current delivery models are:

- Fragmented across multiple suppliers
- Difficult to coordinate
- Inconsistent in reporting
- Lacking clear accountability

This creates contract risk, reporting exposure, internal resource strain, and weak accountability across live projects.

OUR SOLUTION

Forces Group Australia takes accountability for planning, coordinating, enforcing, and reporting Indigenous participation outcomes across major projects.

We act as the single accountable Indigenous participation delivery partner across the project:

- Indigenous workforce participation delivery
- Indigenous supplier engagement and deployment
- Reporting, compliance, and audit accountability

This gives Tier 1 and Tier 2 contractors one accountable Indigenous delivery partner instead of multiple moving parts.
